

IAC Releases Updates to MRI Standards - New Standards Effective March 1, 2018

SEPTEMBER 1, 2017 | As an accreditation organization, IAC MRI is committed to maintaining a program that balances the changing needs of both the MRI community and the general public by influencing the quality of patient care provided. The [IAC Standards and Guidelines for MRI Accreditation](#) are the most important component of that commitment. Composed by physicians, physicists and technologists from the [IAC sponsoring organizations](#), the Standards are reviewed periodically by the Board of Directors and revised as needed.

As a component of the accreditation process, the IAC MRI Board of Directors preliminarily approved the proposed Standards which were posted to the IAC MRI website for a 60-day public comment period from April 5-June 5, 2017. Following careful review and consideration of the comments received, the Board of Directors voted final approval of the Standards.
