

## IAC MRI RELEASES UPDATES TO STANDARDS

JULY 15, 2014 | As an accreditation organization, IAC MRI is committed to maintaining a program that balances the changing needs of both the MRI community and the general public by influencing the quality of patient care provided. The *IAC Standards and Guidelines for MRI Accreditation* are the most important component of that commitment. Composed by physicians, physicists and technologists from the IAC sponsoring organizations, the *Standards* are reviewed periodically by the Board of Directors and revised as needed.

As a component of the accreditation process, once approved by the IAC MRI Board of Directors, proposed *Standards* are posted to the IAC MRI website for a 60-day public comment period. *Standards* that are affected by the most recent public comment period (April 15, 2014 to June 15, 2014) are included in this published version.

### KEY REVISIONS TO THE IAC STANDARDS FOR MRI

Modifications are shown in the current *Standards* in highlighting and include:

- Personnel and Supervision - Technical Staff Required Training and Experience (*Applicable Standard 1.4.1.4Ai*)

**Standards that are highlighted become effective July 15, 2014.** Applications submitted after July 15, 2014 must be in compliance with the new *Standards*.
