



## Minnesota Facilities, Hospitals Furnishing ADI Services Must Be Accredited By 8/1/2013

IAC DESIGNATED AS AN APPROVED ACCREDITING ORGANIZATION

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MAY 1, 2013 | Effective August 1, 2013, Minnesota facilities and hospitals that furnish advanced diagnostic imaging (ADI) services [inclusive of Nuclear/PET, MRI and CT] must be accredited by an organization approved by the US Department of Health and Human Services in order to receive reimbursement.

Without accreditation through one of the approved organizations by August 1, 2013, your facility and/or hospital will not receive reimbursement. The Intersocietal Accreditation Commission (IAC) has been designated as an approved accrediting organization.
